

Bar Council Of India Rules (Rules Of Legal Education, 2008, In Terms Of 'Internship'.)

Schedule III

Clause 25: Minimum period of internship:

- (a) Each registered student shall have to complete Minimum of 12 weeks internship for three year course stream and 20 weeks in case of five years course stream during the entire period of legal studies under NGO. Trial and Appellate Advocates, Judicial, Legal regulatory authorities, Legislatures and parliament, other Legal Functionaries, Market institutions, law Firms, companies, local Self Government and other such bodies as the University shall stipulate, where Law is practiced either in action or in dispute Resolution or in management.

Provided that internship in any year cannot be for a continuous period of more than four weeks and all students shall at least gone through once in the entire academic period with Trial and Appellate Advocates.

- (b) Each student shall keep internship diary in such form as may be stipulated by the University concerned and the same shall be evaluated by the guide internship and also a core Faculty member of the staff in time. The total shall be assessed in final semester of the Course in the 4th Clinical course as stipulated under the rules in Scheduled II.

Clause 27: Formal dress code during internship:

Students placed under internship or in Moot Court exercise shall formal dress of legal professional in pupil age as follows.

(For all) White/ Black trouser, white shirt, black tie, black coat, black shoe and black socks. When students have problems of getting the entire formal dress for any reason, they have to have a white trouser, full sleeve shirt to be tucked-in and covered shoe.

(Optional for the girl students) black printed saree, with white full sleeve blouse and covered black shoe or Lawyer's Suit with black covered shoe.

The Organization or advocate under whom the internee is placed is required to follow suitable dress code.
