**RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE B.R AMBEDKAR MEMORIAL ANNUAL  
HUMAN RIGHTS MOOT COURT COMPETITION,10<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER 2022**

1. All teams must report at the venue at 9 a.m on 10/12/2022
2. Registration:9.am to 9.30 am
3. Each team shall comprise of two speakers and one researcher
4. The moot court competition shall comprise of the following rounds
  - A) Preliminary rounds
  - b)Final round
  
5. The teams must prepare their arguments from both the sides, i.e the petitioner and the respondent
  
6. The preliminary rounds shall comprise of two rounds of oral arguments. In the preliminary rounds, each team shall have to argue twice, once as a petitioner and the other as a respondent. For preliminary rounds, the submission before the honourable court must be made within 12 minutes.10 minutes for both the mooters and 2 minutes for summing up of the arguments.There will not be any rebuttal in the preliminary rounds.the division of time between the mooters shall be at their discretion. The oral arguments should be confined to the issues presented in the memorial
  
7. For the final rounds, the submission before the honourable court must be made within 15 minutes.10 minutes for both the mooters and 2 minutes for summing up of the arguments.3 minutes shall be used for rebuttal
  
8. The memorial shall necessarily consist of the following:
  - a) Cover page
  - b) Table of Contents
  - c) List of Abbreviations
  - d) Index of Authorities

e) Statement of Jurisdiction

f) Statement of Facts

g) Issues raised

h) Summary of arguments

i) Advance arguments

J) Prayer

9. All teams must submit two copies of memorials of each side(two from petitioners side,two from respondent's side.

10.Following shall be the marking criteria and marks allotted per mooter:

12.Content specification of the moot memorials

I. Font and size (general) - times new roman, 12 pts

ii. Line spacing (general) - 1.5 lines

Iii. Font and size (footnotes) - times new roman, 10 pts

iv. Line spacing (footnotes) - single line

v. Page margins - 1 inch on all sides

vi. The hard copies of the memorial shall be printed on only one side.

Vii. The citation should be in compliance with the ILI method of citation
